We currently seek to recruit an Electrical Technician to undertake electrical maintenance and inspection duties to meet the requirements of planned maintenance schedules and support and maintain the reliability and integrity of control systems and respond to plant, equipment and control system failures.

Duties will include:

Working to planned maintenance, inspection procedures and schedules.

Responding to corrective maintenance and inspection defects, maintaining records and plant history files.

Assisting with the maintenance of IT Systems and equipment at operational sites.

Supervising colleagues and contractors in safe systems of work, including preparing risk assessments, work procedures, method statements and gas testing procedures.

Responding to emergency situations including dealing with emergency authorities.

Working additional hours and participating in an out of hours call out rota to fulfil extraordinary maintenance, inspection duties and project work.

Required Experience/Job Skills

In order to fulfil this role, candidates will have a recognised qualification in a relevant electrical discipline to NVQ level 3 or equivalent standard, have previous experience in maintenance and fault finding of electrical plant, equipment and control systems and have working knowledge of standard control and instrumentation devices. An understanding of standard networked IT systems is also required and candidates must have knowledge of Electricity at Work Regulations and the latest wiring regulations.

A certified electrical apprenticeship is desirable as is CompEx qualifications for hazardous area equipment.
